Wisconsin's not alone as a lumber feeder to the city by furnishing through its numerous tributaries an outlet for thousands of car loads of lumber, but it also furnishes a water power that is second only to that of Wisconsin, and the great quantities are also located on the "Central."
 Millions of feet of lumber are cut every day, giving employment to hundreds of men. In addition to the lumber trade, it has numerous other manufactures, it is here where the large cities of Wisconsin Central are located.
