ORDINANCE NO. 1.—An ordinance to regulate and license the sale of Spirituous Wines, fermented, and distilled liquors, in the City of Brainerd. The Common Council of the City of Brainerd, do ordain as follows: SECTION 1. Any person or persons applying for license to sell spirituous, vinous, fermented or distilled liquors, within the limits of the City of Brainerd, before the same is granted, shall pay to the Treasurer the sum of seventy-five dollars, upon filing with the City Recorder, the Treasurer's receipt for the same, and submitting and filing the same with the City Recorder, to be approved by the Council in the next session of the Board of Health, and if the person, so licensed, will not sell or otherwise dispose of any spirituous, vinous, fermented, and distilled liquors, other than that at the place designated in said license; nor on the Sabbath day, or on any day next thereafter, or on any day at night, and until daylight the succeeding day, nor keep open such place of business after and during the hours of business on any general or special election day, nor to minors or any person of unsound mind, nor to an habitual drunkard, nor to any person or persons, after notification in writing, by him or her or their relatives, or the Board of Health, to sell, or to allow to him, her, or them, and that he will in all respects keep a quiet and orderly house, and not permit gaming, or any other game, or other device, for money or the representative of money, in the house or place of business of such person, or allow any person or persons, attached by the Recorder, which license shall not be granted for less term than one year, and all licenses shall commence and terminate on the first day of January of each year; provided, that they shall be no transfer of said license, nor the place of dealing in liquor, as designed therein, be changed, without the consent of the Council thereon.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars, nor more than fifty dollars, and in default of payment, shall be imprisoned for not less than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall be found guilty, within the limits of the City of Brainerd, of the violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars, nor more than fifty dollars, and in default of payment, shall be imprisoned for not less than thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4.—An ordinance to prevent indecent exposure of person or conduct, and lewd conduct or obscene or filthy act, or the exposing for sale of obscene pictures, &c. Any person who shall appear in any street or public place in said city, in a dress not belonging to his or her sex, or in any indecent or obscene dress, or shall make any indecent exposure of his or her person, or be guilty of any obscene or filthy act, or of any lewd, indecent, immoral or insulting conduct, language or behavior, or shall exhibit, sell or offer for sale any indecent or lewd book or picture or other thing; or shall exhibit or perform any indecent, immoral or lewd play, or other representation, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in a sum not exceeding fifty dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall intentionally, wantonly beat, injure or obstruct any animal within the city limits, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars.

SECTION 3.—To prevent the careless use of Fire-arms, Crackers, &c. The Common Council of the City of Brainerd, do ordain as follows: SECTION 1. Whoever shall carelessly use, or discharge any gun, revolver or cracker, within the limits of the City of Brainerd, or discharge any gun, pistol, revolver or fire-arms, on the public streets, or other public place, within said city, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, for the first offense, and upon conviction for a second offense, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, and by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.

SECTION 2. Whoever shall carelessly use, or discharge any gun, pistol, revolver or cracker, within the limits of the City of Brainerd, or discharge any gun, pistol, revolver or fire-arms, on the public streets, or other public place, within said city, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, for the first offense, and upon conviction for a second offense, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars, and by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days.
