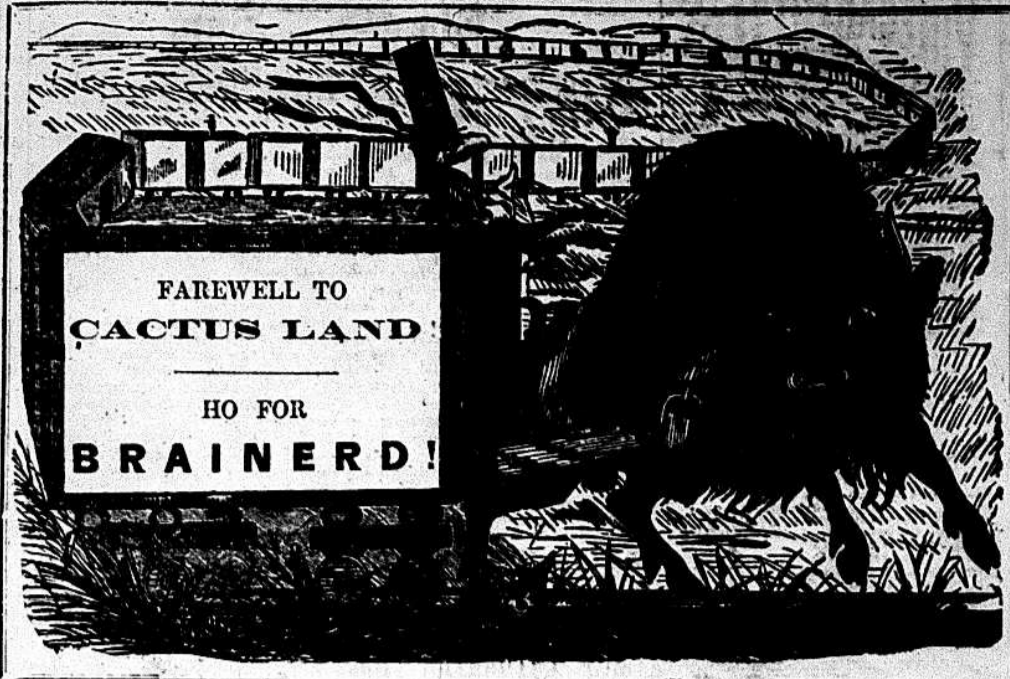


Departure of the "Last Train" from Bismarck.
